

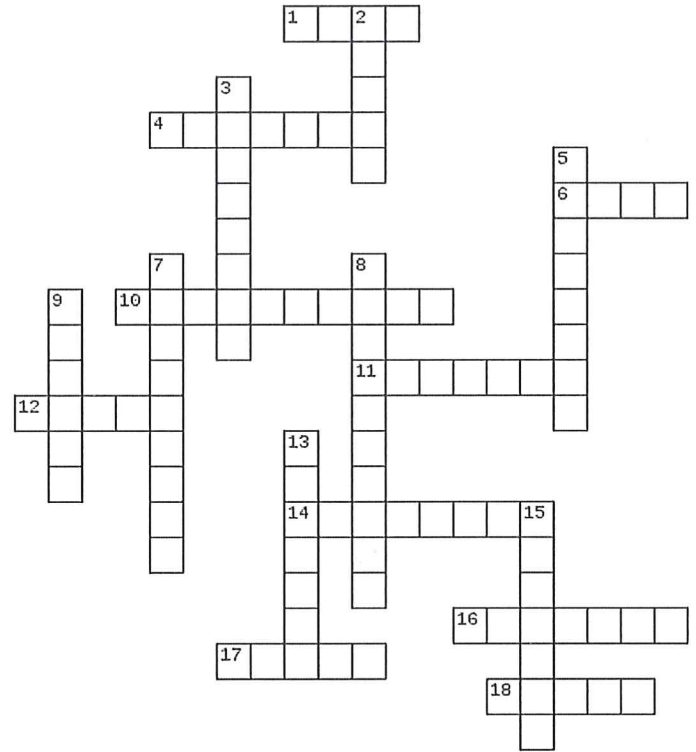
Instruments are put in families by the way they are produced and played.
